HARBOR RADIO PROCEDURES - Understand and follow proper radio procedures.

- Lahaina Harbor Traffic - VHF channel 68.
- Departure
 - Prior to departing slip #42 announce the vessel's name & your intentions, when clear AND you have right of way, proceed. Once clear of the harbor channel switch & monitor channel 16.
- Return
 - Prior to arriving at the "L" buoy monitor channel 68.
 - Upon arrival to the "L" buoy announce the vessel's name & your intentions to return to slip #42. When clear AND you have right of way, proceed.
 - Instruct crew to prepare for return to slip and place fenders appropriately.
- **Cruise Ship Days** (see LYC boat calendar for scheduled days).
- **YOU WILL BE UNDER THE CONTROL OF HARBOR AUTHORITY - DO NOT ATTEMPT TO DEPART OR ENTER HARBOR WITHOUT PERMISSION FROM LAHAINA HARBOR MASTER.**
